

## **NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CHECKLIST**

## APPLY TO HARTFORD INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY

	Submit your HIU Application	
	Track your admission status and keep in touch with <u>Michelle Federer</u> , Interim Director of Admissions.	
WHEN YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER COMES		
	Submit a copy of your passport. Apply for a passport as soon as possible if you do not have one. HIU must receive a copy of your passport in order to issue you an I-20. To avoid any delay, please ensure your passport is not expired, and valid for at least 6 months post academic program	
	Obtain a Form I-20 by completing the <u>International Student Financial Guarantee</u> . A letter from the institution on letterhead with seal and signature is required, verifying the financial ability of the Guarantor. Please submit a clear photocopy of the biographic page of your passport. If you currently hold a visa in the U.S., please provide a clear copy of that as well. Please send your Financial Guarantee Form, bank statements and supporting documents at your earliest convenience so we can start processing your I-20. <b>MAP</b> applicants <b>do not need to complete this form.</b>	
	Pay the <u>SEVIS 1-901</u> fee once you receive your Form 1-20. <u>Watch this video for step-by-step instructions</u> . HIU pays the SEVIS fee for all students accepted into the MAP program.	
	Contact your corresponding U.S embassy or consulate to schedule your visa interview. You can find wait times for visa applications <a href="here">here</a> .	
	Prepare the required documents for your visa interview. In addition to filling out the Form DS-160 online, check the website for the US Consulate/Embassy where you will be interviewed to see what documents are required.

	✓ Form I-20	
	✓ Proof of funding/sponsorship as reflected on the form I-20	
	✓ Passport	
	✓ Proof of ties to your home country and intent to return after studying	
	✓ Any other recommendations based on the embassy or consulate website

	Submit your immunization/vaccination records to the Registrar. Please see Immunization	

Requirements.

	Contact the <u>Housing Department</u> , if you want to live on campus. Space is limited, so do this as soon as possible.	
	Make sure to arrange a ride from Bradley International Airport or Hartford Union Station to HIU. You can do so by sending an email to <u>HIU International Admissions.</u>	
	Reach out to Student Services to prepare or set up your health insurance plan.	
	Complete your initial registration by submitting the New Student Registration Form.	
	Set-up and access your HIU email. This is extremely important. Be on the lookout for an email from the Registrar's office.	
WHEN YOU ARE ON CAMPUS		
	Update your local address and phone number in Populi.	
	Meet with your advisor and enroll in classes.	
	Attend both the Student Orientation and the International Student Orientation.	
	If you have any condition that may prevent you from excelling in graduate-level work, please complete and submit the <u>Request for Accommodations Form</u> . You should also contact your instructors to discuss learning needs and any additional accommodations needed to succeed.	
	Complete the Student Services Survey (tbc) and Student Interests Form.	
	There are a limited number of jobs available each year on campus, if you are interested, you can contact Human Resources.
