Graduation rates and time to completion are defined by the 36 credits required in both the MAC and the MAIRS programs. Full-time enrollment is defined as 9 credits per semester, fall and spring. Thus, a student is 100% on time if they graduate after the fourth semester in either of these two-year programs, assuming full-time enrollment. 150% would represent a student completing in 3 years and so on. Anticipated graduation rates, above, are determined by an assessment of the average number of credits accumulated per semester for students as they progress through their program.
