International applicants are exempt from submitting English Proficiency test scores if:

- English was the language of instruction. This requirement will be waived once we have received documentation from your institution. Please arrange to have the dean's office or registrar send us a language of instruction statement directly to admissions@hartfordinternational.edu.
- The applicant is a citizen or national of the countries listed below. This requirement will be waived upon receipt of proof of citizenship (i.e., a copy of your passport biographical page).
- Applicants who are in the process of completing or have completed a university-level degree (bachelor's, master's, etc.) in the United States of America. This requirement will be waived upon receipt and evaluation of an official U.S. transcript.
