



ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY ATTESTATION

Students who do not have English as a first language, or as a primary language in previous academic studies, are required, prior to application, to take either the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) examination and achieve a minimum score of 550 (written version), 213 (computer version) or 80 (internet version), or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) and achieve a minimum score of 6.5. Applications for admission will not be processed without official TOEFL/IELTS scores. [Please see English language proficiency exemptions.](#)

Prospective students should have sufficient English language proficiency to participate successfully in the proposed program and function on a day-to-day basis. The student's English proficiency should be determined by an objective measurement, such as a recognized English language test (TOEFL or IELTS) or interview conducted by the department official in person, by video conference or, if unavailable, by telephone. Documentation of the sponsor's determination of English proficiency must be submitted to and maintained by the Responsible Officer for three years following the completion of the program.
